Gateway Community College Foundation serves the students of Gateway Community College, the largest of CT's 12 community colleges. Gateway students' demographics: 63% identify as female and 37% male, 24% Black 28% Hispanic, 37% White, 55% are 18 to 24; 41% over 25, and 4% under 18. 38% are Pell grant eligible.

The Foundation provides student scholarships and fellowships, technology grants, and aid for educational and emergency needs. The Foundation also provides support to faculty and staff for professional development.
